Key Person Interview

This questionnaire has been put together to be used with key people in your community, such as police, teachers, shop keepers, social workers, or any other people you recognise as being central to your community.

You could also use it with friends and neighbours. Tailor the questions if necessary to fit the person and their role.

If you want a shorter version for a street survey pick a few key questions e.g. 5, 6, 9, 12, 13, 15.

- 1) Name
- 2) Age
- 3) Role within the community
- 4) Length of time in the community?
- 5) What do you like most about this community?

- 6) What most helps to build community here?

- 7) Where are the places in the community where people can gather together?

- 8) How would you describe the people in this community?

- 9) What do you think the main needs of people in this community are?

- 10) How do people here spend most of their time? What are their lifestyles typically like?

- 11) Is there anything significant (celebrations/tragedies/tension) in the history of this community?

- 12) What concerns you about this community?

- 13) What things do people in the community want to change?
